KEM Youth Football Club has been established in January 2007 by the congregation of Kingdom Exchange Ministries which is a group of Christians who believe in the bible and believe in encouraging children to share their skills with others and to reach their own full potential.

The club is self financing and is run by a committee with an established constitution. The committee is democratically elected each year at the Club's Annual General Meeting and is made up of managers and representatives from each team, mainly long standing, dedicated members.

Day to day management is in the capable hands of the elected officers of the club and regular monthly meetings are held to discuss routine and non-routine matters throughout the year. Any parent or guardian can attend the A.G.M. or express a view in writing or via a committee member at any committee meeting.

Should our application be successful (decision by their committee early June 2007) then the club will be part of the Invicta Primary League (IPL), which is itself affiliated to the Kent Football Association and this body in turn abides by rules and codes laid down by the Football Association.

Fund Raising & Social Events

For the club to maintain its high standards in the provision of equipment, kit, pitches and facilities for the boys it needs to hold a number of events in order to raise funds. In the past such events have included: - 24 hour Football Marathons, Penalty Competition/Fundays, Sponsored Walks, Quiz Nights, Boot & Jumble Sales to name but a few. Some events, like our Fun Nights at the Black Lion Leisure Centre; our Anglo/Dutch Tournament; our trips to see International Games; our Annual Dinner & Dance and our Presentation Evenings are purely for pleasure and are great social occasions for the club as a whole.
